On behalf of the Chief, UNEP Environmental Education and Training Unit, I wish to welcome Sree Narayana Institute of Technology – Snit Adoor to the Global Universities Partnership on Environment and Sustainability (GUPES).

The goal of GUPES is to promote the mainstreaming of environment and sustainability practices and curricula into universities by supporting innovative approaches to education. This is done in accordance to the UN Decade of Education for Sustainable Development (2005-14), the outcome document of the Rio+20 Summit, the Global Action Programme on Education for Sustainable Development (ESD); target 4.7 of the Sustainable Development Goals: Environmental Education; and the recently passed UNEA2 Resolution “***Investing in human capacity for sustainable development through environmental education and training***”.

GUPES in collaboration with partners has rolled-out three Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) on Climate Change Adaptation; Disaster Risk Reduction; Marine Litter to enhance global environmental capacity; and E-Waste, with more MOOCs earmarked for launch.
